MIMO 2014 - Malaysia Invitational Mathematics Olympiad Competition (MIMO)

The candidate from class 3 to 6 has participated in the MIMO competitions conducted by Malaysia Mathematics Olympiad Society and Persatuan Matematik Olympiad Malaysia (PERMATO). The students from GIIS Malaysia have won 1st Runner up in the upper primary and 11 Bronze medals.

In the series of Inter House competitions, GIIS, KL Secondary Campus organised a language elocution competition on 25th of November, 2014. The finalists were selected through rigorous selection rounds conducted by their respective subject teachers, during the regular second language classes.

72 students were selected across Grade 3, 4 and 5 who very confidently presented their language skills.
